NATURBIND® S80 is a natural sepiolite clay specifically processed for animal feed applications. Its high binding capacity, absorption properties, and fibrous structure improve pellet durability, reduce dust, enhance flowability, and aid in nutrient delivery. It is an inert, non-toxic, and safe additive widely used in compound feed formulations.

NATURBIND® S80 is 100% natural, inert, and non-toxic, compliant with international safety standards and EU Feed Additive Regulation (EC No. 1831/2003) where it is listed as technological additive under Additive Code E562.

Recommended addition rate for NATURBIND® S80 in feed formula is 0.5 – 2.0% (5–20 kg/ton).
